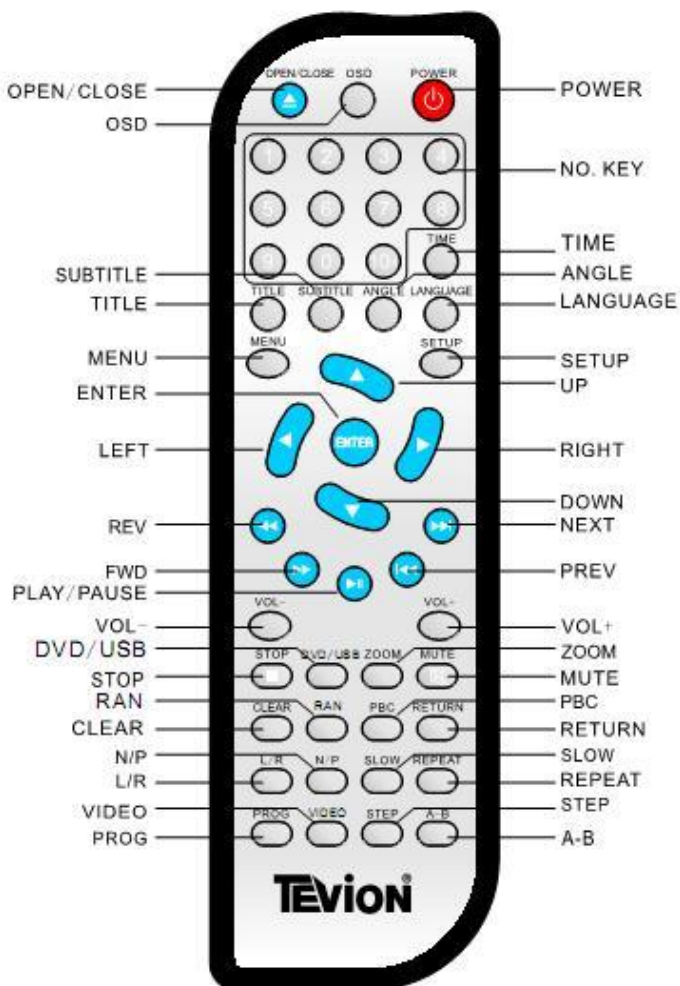

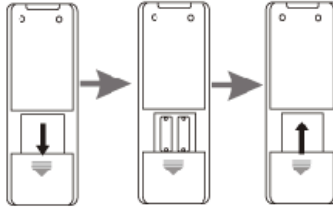

Remote Control Functions

The remote control requires 2 x AAA batteries (supplied). Slide off the back cover and insert batteries ensuring the correct +/- polarity. Slide the cover back on until it clicks into place. Always ensure to point the remote control directly at the infra-red sensor on the front of the DVD player.

Battery Installation

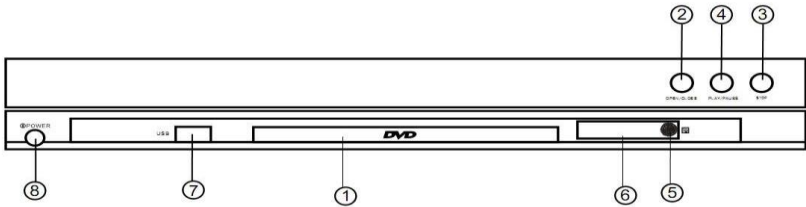


Remote Control Operating Conditions

1. Aim remote control at remote sensor of DVD.
2. Do not drop the unit from a high position or cause high impacts.
3. Do not place the remote control in hot or moist environments.
4. Do not splash water or any other liquid on remote control.
5. The remote control works best within 7metres from the DVD player.
6. Do not expose the remote control sensor directly to a heat source or it will malfunction.

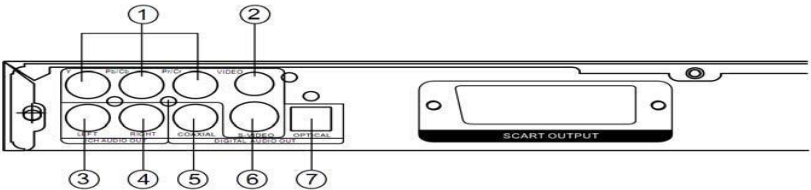

Connecting Your DVD Player

This product has a choice of three connections but these cannot be connected at the same time.

The choice of connection will depend on the video jack on your TV,

- In order to connect your DVD to your TV simply use the scart lead provided to connect from the scart socket on the DVD to the scart socket on your TV itself. Then connect the power supply to a mains socket.
- Also via the AV Output socket from the DVD player using the AV cable provided (red, yellow and white) to the AV Input on your TV
- Also via the RGB socket (red, green and blue) from the DVD player to the RGB socket on your TV

Connecting to a HIFI System

If you also want to have your HIFI System connected to the DVD player you can connect via the audio output socket on the DVD using a RCA cable (red on the right, white on the left) but you must have Audio In on the HIFI System. You can also connect via an amplifier if you do not have Audio In on your HIFI System.

After completing the connection of your appliance you can now switch the power to on and press the power button on the front of the unit. When you switch on your DVD your TV may automatically divert to the DVD mode and will display the Tevion logo on your TV screen (this is not the case for all appliances.) If this does not display then you may need to change your TV into the input mode you chose example scart, AV or RGB (refer to your TV user manual on how to do this.)

You will also need to press the 'Video' button on your remote to select the input mode of the DVD


- S-Video, choose S-video mode
- (Y.Cb,Cr) choose YUV mode
- Scart choose RGB mode

If you have an audio system connected you will need to choose the correct audio output on the amplifier (refer to your amplifier manual on how to do this.)

Disc Loading

Do not play any cracked broken or deformed disc. The disc is rotated at high speed, so it is very dangerous to play any broken or deformed disc and this may cause damage to the player.





Step 1: Press the 'open/close' button, the disc tray will slide out automatically
Step 2: Load a disc into the tray and press 'open/close' the screen will indicate loading and the player will identify the format of the disc, and then indicate it on the upper left of the TV screen

- After reading the disc it will go to the menu of the DVD or title menu
- When playing CD discs it will play in the sequence chapter number

Operation

During disc playback to pause the DVD press the 'play/pause' button and press this again to resume normal play Press the 'stop' button once to stop your DVD and press 'play/pause' to resume. Press the stop button for the second time to stop the DVD completely.

Press 'previous' button, the previous chapter will be played


Press 'next' button, the next chapter will be played

By pressing the 'forward' or 'rewind' button continuously you can change the speed of skipping x2, x4, x8, x16, x32.

You can select a desired subtitle from the available ones encoded on the disc, this operation is only available with supported DVDs press the 'subtitle' button continuously to change between languages.

Some DVDs also have the angle feature so you can view the film from another angle, if your DVD supports this option press the 'angle' button to change viewing angle.

During DVD playback press the 'title' button to return to the DVD root menu use the direction buttons to navigate through the menu, in the chapter selection menu you can use the numeric buttons to select the desired chapter.



With CD playback press the numeric buttons to select the track or use the direction buttons to navigate to the chosen track.

When using VCD discs press the PBC button to return to root menu.

Press the 'N/P' button to select either format NTSC or PAL, this will depend on the colour format of your TV.

Press the 'slow' button during DVD playback to view your disc in slow motion press this continuously to change speed 1/2, 1/4, 1/8, 1/16.

Press the 'step' button to freeze the frame and continuously press this to move from frame to frame. Press the 'play/pause' button to resume normal play

You can zoom in on your DVD by pressing the 'zoom' button the zoom size will display on screen until you resume normal size playback press this continuously to increase the zoom x2, x3, x4.

The USB reader only performs MP3 and JPEG picture playback. The maximum capacity the USB will accept is 4GB.

Power on your DVD player ensuring no disc is inserted in the tray, now insert the USB device and press the 'DVD/USB' button. Use the direction keys to navigate to the USB option, press 'enter' to select this and a waiting message will appear on your TV screen then press 'enter' again to confirm USB. Your files will then display on the screen, you can select your desired file using the direction keys to navigate to this and 'enter' button to confirm this.

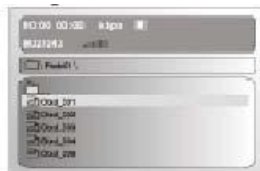


Please note if using a MP3 CD you can access your files as shown above.

With USB and MP3 music selection you have the option for repeat press the 'repeat' button to select from single song play, single song repeat, folder repeat or folder play. Press 'repeat' continuously and your choice will display on the bottom of your screen.

JPEG Picture Operation

When viewing JPEG pictures your screen will display as below use the direction keys to navigate to the picture you wish to view and press the 'enter' button to view the image on screen. This will automatically go from picture to picture within the folder you can use the direction keys to rotate your picture on screen. At any time press the 'title' button to return to the root menu.



To enter your Setup Menu select 'setup' button to navigate through the menu use the direction keys and 'enter' to confirm your selection.

Symptom	Remedy
No Power	Insert the AC adaptor securely into the power outlet
No Picture	Ensure the equipment is connected properly
	Ensure you are in the correct mode on both the player and your TV
	Ensure the TV video socket is working properly
No Sound	Check the audio settings are correct
	Check the input setting for the TV and stereo system are correct
	Ensure the equipment is connected properly
The Disc Does Not Load	Ensure the disc has been inserted into the tray correctly (with label facing up)
	Make sure your disc is clean with no scratches
	Ensure the disc format is compatible
The Remote Does Not Respond	Check the batteries are in the correct polarity
	You are pointing the remote control at the sensor on the player and not your TV
My USB Is Not Loading	Ensure you are in USB mode
	Check the USB is connected securely
	Check files are compatible with the player
